### **What: Celebrate Port Credit's 175<sup>th</sup> Anniversary with Your Creativity**

The Port Credit 175<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Committee and Port Credit Village Project would like to invite all non-profit community groups and local schools in the Port Credit area to help celebrate the Port Credit 175<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. Groups will be given the opportunity to paint their vision of Port Credit themes on designated panels of the construction hoarding that will be installed around Port Credit Arena and Port Credit Library construction site, 10 panels on each site. A community painting day is planned for first weekend of May.

**When: Community Paint Day - Saturday, May 1, 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.**

**Who: Non Profit Volunteer Groups and schools from the Port Credit Community.**

Participation is on a first come basis - request to participate in writing and one authorized representative from group. A maximum of 18 groups will be accepted. No Individual Artists.

**How:** Using the guiding principles and mission statement for Port Credit 175<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration, design your own depiction of this milestone birthday. The goal is: To Celebrate our Heritage, Pride and Future.

**Criteria:** No advertising will be accepted as part of the overall design (with the exception of project sponsors and donors as deemed appropriate by the Port Credit 175<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Executive Committee. Group participation is pending approval of draft submission to Port Credit 175<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Executive Committee.

**Hoarding dimensions:** Each board is 4 feet wide and 8 feet tall. Groups will be allowed to extend to maximum of 2 boards.

**Community Paint Day:** Groups will be asked to participate on the designated community paint day. Paint, rolling trays, rollers and brushes will be supplied to the group leader. Primary paint colours will be supplied in a limited quantity. Groups can mix paint as needed.

Boards will be primed prior to community paint day. Food and beverage will be on site during the community painting day. If possible, extra volunteers and art assistants will be on site to assist groups to transcribe their ideas onto the hoarding.
